

An Unexpected Turn

A1

- (1-4) All set and cloverleaf turn single
 { 1st corners over L shoulder, 2nd corners over R shoulder }
- (5-8) #1 couple lead down center and cast back to original place

A2

- (1-4) All mad robin (1's down, 2's up, men start outside)
- (5-8) Gypsy neighbor on the side by R shoulder

B1

- (1-4) Star L with adjacent neighbors (1's above, 2's below)
- (5-8) LH turn that same neighbor just starred with, on side.

B2

- (1-2) All join hands in long lines, set to R & L as a line
- (3-4) Surge across, passing through by R shoulder and turn in (over R shoulder)
- (5-8) "Gypsy Roundabout" move, as follows:
All move into center of set, gypsy like a traffic circle to progressed improper place;
In other words, all take 2 steps toward center of each set, forming a tight circle facing your same sex neighbor (no hands), then in 2 beats or so move clockwise 180 degrees to opposite same sex neighbor's place (kind of like two half gypsies at once), then take the rest of the 8 beats to back out into progressed improper place and face your partner.
