- A1 1-2 Set to partner.
 3-4 Turn partner two-hands half-way,
 opening to face other couple.
 5-8 Back to back with neighbor.
- A2 9-10 Set to neighbor.
 11-12 Turn that person two-hands half-way,
 opening to face partner.
 13-16 Back to back with partner.
- B1 17-20 Twos cast down to the middle of a line of 4
 while ones lead up and cast
 to the ends of the line
 21-24 Lead up four & fall back bending the line.
- B2 25-28 Two changes of Rights & Lefts,
 starting with partner.
 29-32 Partner two-hand turn.
