About the Tune:

The tune first appeared in print courtesy of the intrepid composer and collector James Oswald (1711-1769) in his 1741 collection, *Curious Scots Tunes*, but was certainly older. In the Gillespie manuscript of c. 1768, the tune is re-titled “Miss Faw’s Minuet,” and one cannot but wonder what she made of the compliment implied.
